Scholarship Award: 500 word essay and transcripts

Leadership Award: 500 word essay

Marketing Award: Contestant with highest ticket and ad sales

Congeniality Award: Most supportive and kind contestant – selected by contestants

Director's Award: Most diligent and professional contestant – selected by Director

V. ENTRY FEE DUE IN FULL AND PAPERWORK DUE MARCH 24, 2019

1. Seven copies signed application in three-hole plastic page protectors
2. Seven copies platform page in three-hole plastic page protectors
3. Each contestant receives a half-page ad (\$200.00 value). Contestant also receive \$25% of all ad sales after the first ad sold. All ad money due March 24, 2019.
4. Documentation: birth certificate, driver's license, marriage certificate

VI. SCHOLARSHIPS

Miss and Teen state winners are eligible for four (4) year half tuition scholarship to Hollins University, Roanoke, Virginia (up to \$50,000).

Miss and Teen International Winners are also eligible for a full four (4) year scholarship if they are in the Top Three at the International competition (up to \$100,000).

The winner must meet Hollins University eligibility requirements. Cash scholarships may also be available based on funding.
